



- **Mark 6:30-7:37 = Cycle #1** of His lesson to His disciples.
  - **Mark 8:1-30 = Cycle #2** ... because they were slow to learn.

## **John 10:11**

“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.”

# 1) Miraculous Feeding (6:30-44)

**A denarius = a day's wage for a laborer.**

# 1) Miraculous Feeding (6:30-44)

“Having admitted their inability, Jesus’ ability would make a greater impression on them. It would teach them that He was different from them. The disciples’ response shows that they had not yet learned to look to Jesus for all their needs. Instead of asking Him to provide what the people needed, they calculated the cost of the food and concluded that they could not afford to pay for it.”

## 2 Corinthians 12:9

But he said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

# 1) Miraculous Feeding (6:30-44)

## Key Ideas:

- Jesus provides for our needs, like a Good, Compassionate Shepherd.
- We must look to the Provider, not the provision; the Source rather than ourselves.

## 2) Miraculous Walking (6:45-52)

### Exodus 3:14

God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.” And he said, “Say this to the people of Israel: ‘I AM has sent me to you.’”

### Exodus 33:19

And he said, “I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name ‘The LORD.’ And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy.”

## 2) Miraculous Walking (6:45-52)

### Key Ideas:

- We can also be slow to learn Jesus' lessons due to our hardness of heart.
- Jesus, the Great "I AM" is present with us, even if He seems absent.




