The Gospel of Luke gives us most of the key details in the Christmas story. This year we are going to slow down and take a close look at Luke's Christmas story. Each day we are only going to read 1-4 verses and so read them once, read the question, and then read the verses again as you think about the question.

**December 3<sup>rd</sup>** – Luke 1:5-7 (What does it mean to be righteous before God? Are you?)

**December 4**th – <u>Luke 1:8-12</u> (What scares you about following God?)

**December 5**<sup>th</sup> – Luke 1:13-15 (Which of your prayers has God answered in your life?)

**December 6**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 1:16-17</u> (Do you think God has plans for you when you grow up like he did for John?)

**December 7**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 1:18-20</u> (Why did Zechariah doubt the angel? Do you ever doubt God?)

**December 8**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 1:21-25</u> (Do you ever have a hard time telling others about your experiences with God?)

**December 9**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 1:26-27</u> (Why do you think God wanted Mary to get pregnant before being married to Joseph?)

**December 11**th – Luke 1:28-29 (Why was Mary afraid and worried when the angel spoke to her?)

**December 12**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 1:30-33</u> (Do you think your parents envisioned God doing great things through you before you were born?)

**December 13**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 1:34-35</u> (What do you think the role of the Holy Spirit is in our lives today?)

**December 14**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 1:36-38</u> (Is there anything in your life that seems impossible that you need God's help with?)

**December 15**th – Luke 1:57-60 (What are you rejoicing about this Christmas season?)

**December 16th** – Luke 1:61-64 (What can you bless or thank God for right now in your life?)

**December 17**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 1:65-66</u> (What do you think God's presence in your life could mean for your future?)

**December 18**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 2:4-7</u> (Why is it significant that Jesus was born in a manger?)

**December 19**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 2:8-9</u> (Why did God want shepherds to be a part of the Christmas story?)

**December 21**st – <u>Luke 2:10-14</u> (Why do we call Jesus a Savior?)

**December 22<sup>nd</sup>** – <u>Luke 2:15-18</u> (Why should the birth story of Jesus make us want to quickly go and learn more?)

**December 23<sup>rd</sup>** – <u>Luke 2:19-20</u> (What is your reaction to the good news of Jesus?)

**December 24**<sup>th</sup> – <u>Luke 2:21</u> (Do you think God had plans for you before you were even born?)
