The Gospel of Luke gives us most of the key details in the Christmas story. This year we are going to slow down and take a close look at Luke’s Christmas story. Each day we are only going to read 1-4 verses and so read them once, read the question, and then read the verses again as you think about the question.

December 3rd – [Luke 1:5-7](#) (What does it mean to be righteous before God? Are you?)

December 4th – [Luke 1:8-12](#) (What scares you about following God?)

December 5th – [Luke 1:13-15](#) (Which of your prayers has God answered in your life?)

December 6th – [Luke 1:16-17](#) (Do you think God has plans for you when you grow up like he did for John?)

December 7th – [Luke 1:18-20](#) (Why did Zechariah doubt the angel? Do you ever doubt God?)

December 8th – [Luke 1:21-25](#) (Do you ever have a hard time telling others about your experiences with God?)

December 9th – [Luke 1:26-27](#) (Why do you think God wanted Mary to get pregnant before being married to Joseph?)

December 11th – [Luke 1:28-29](#) (Why was Mary afraid and worried when the angel spoke to her?)

December 12th – [Luke 1:30-33](#) (Do you think your parents envisioned God doing great things through you before you were born?)

December 13th – [Luke 1:34-35](#) (What do you think the role of the Holy Spirit is in our lives today?)
