

Mentoring Moments Week 5

Mentoring Moments are meant to extend the lesson your child studies in Sunday School with your guidance and encouragement. If time does not permit the completion of the activity, using just the Scripture and discussion questions can provide a *Mentoring Moment* anywhere, even in the car. To start ask your child about the Kids on Mission video they watched during large group today!

Choice 1

Scripture: Romans 12: 6-8

Activity: As a family, share what strengths you see in each other.

For Discussion: What strengths do you have that you can use for Jesus? Talk about some of the ways that you want to use those strengths in the month ahead.

Prayer Point: Ask God to help you discover your talents and show you how to best use them for him.

Choice 2

Scripture: Mark 12:41-43

Activity: Look up Bible verses that talk about money and how we are to use it.

For Discussion: What do you think is more important to God: the size of your gift, or your willingness to use it for Him? Is any gift too small?

Prayer Point: Ask God to make you willing to use your talents, time and treasure to show/tell others about His awesome love and grace.

Choice 3

Scripture: Matthew 25:28-29

Activity: Brainstorm with your family and find someone in the Bible who was reluctant to use his or her talents or resources to serve God? What happened?

For Discussion: How do you think it would feel to stand before God and tell Him you didn't want to use the talents, time and treasure he gave you to serve Him?

Prayer Point: Ask God to make you willing to use your talents, time and treasure any way He wants you to with anyone He wants you to at any time He wants you to.
