- 2. What does verse 21 tell us about their attitudes in taking it?
- 3. Who instituted Lord's Supper? Why? (see vesres 23-26) What emotions or thoughts do you typically have while participating in the Lord's Supper?
- 4. How do we avoid experiencing the judgment of God? (see verse 31)
- 5. Do you think God has a right to judge His creation? How you feel about discussing God's judgment?
- 6. What is the purpose of discipline/judgment? (see verse 32)
- 7. What advise does Paul give to the Corinthian church so that they wouldn't use the Lord's supper as merely a place to fill their appetites and thirst? (see verses 33-34)
- 8. What can you doing to help foster unity in the communities in which you are involved?
