- 4. What is your response to Jesus's authority?
- 5. Why is it important to know Jesus' words? Do you have any disciplines/practices in your life to ensure that you are very familiar with Jesus' words? What are they?
- 6. In Matthew 9:36, what character attribute stands out in this verse? What are the connections of Matthew 9:36 and Matthew 5:1?
- 7. What was the state of the crowds that Jesus on which Jesus had compassion? Is this your perception of the crowds of people you know? Why or why not?
- 8. Are you in need of a shepherd? If not, what is it like to have a shepherd?
- 9. Among whom or what does Jesus send us?
- 10. Look up verses in chapter 10 where Jesus after revealing himself then says, "Don't be afraid." Why are these words so important to hear?
