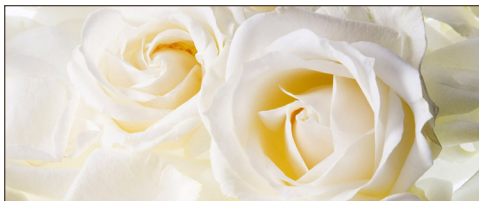

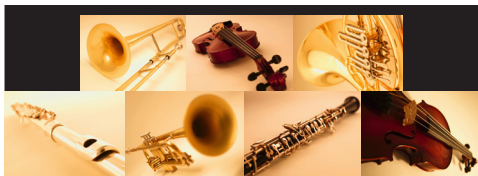
FLORAL GUILD
