### **Position Summary**

Because there are so many students in our congregation, it is not always feasible for the staff to weekly pour into every single student. A High School Small Group Leader is a position designed to relationally connect and pour into the lives of the teenagers in Williamsburg. You will have an opportunity to help teenagers connect, grow and serve in their relationship with Jesus as well as grow in your own relationship with Christ through teachings at our bi-weekly leader meetings.

Specific Duties/Opportunities:

- Weekly small groups on Sunday nights
- Attend high school events regularly
- Attend leader meetings every other week
- Attend Sunday AM services weekly
- Mid-year meeting with a staff member to discuss small groups and potential growth within the group
- Intentionality with students in your small group

Estimated Weekly Time Commitment: Sunday 6:30-8, bi-weekly leader meetings, and volunteer presence at large group events including Wiffleball World Series, HS Fall Retreat, High School Large Groups and Ski Trip.
