

Small Group Leaders' Guide | Additional Sermon Questions, October 9th 2016
The Movement of God's People | 40 Days and David (1 Samuel 17:1-23)

1. David was the most illogical answer for Goliath. What ways have you been looking past Jesus to your own solutions for the Goliaths in your life? (fear counts as a logical response) What armor are you putting on that doesn't fit? Has God been working in ways you've ignored?
2. What has been your response to the true champion, Jesus, so far in your life? What do you still need to give up, like Jonathan did to David, to Jesus Christ?
3. How might you empower someone else with the truth of David vs Goliath? How might you show someone that Jesus is our true Champion?

Workplace Application:

4. Satan isolates and creates lies at work, what are your Goliaths during the week? What armor are you wearing from 8-5? What battles can you not win?
5. How can trusting in Jesus' dominion over all of our lives impact the way we interact with our co-workers/clients/supervisors?
6. What implications do Humility, Honesty and Surrender have for the way we do business and our goals in work? The way we relate to one another?

Study Guide Clarification:

Question 10: Consider fruits of the Holy Spirit (Gal 5:22-23). What are some things that Jesus promised about the Holy Spirit? If he is our comforter and counselor, how should we seek the Spirit out in our daily lives?
