

## Small Group Questions | February 11th, 2018

Kingdom Wisdom – Plans ([Proverbs 15:31-16:9](#), [25](#), [32-33](#))

**Sermon Recap:** Travis preached that Proverbs instructs us to plan in partnership with God. This partnership is necessary, paradoxical, costly, and face to face. We can trust God because he sent his best wisdom down to us, Jesus.

**Hook:** *These questions can help encourage conversation.*

1. Which perspective on plans (“Its Determined” or “I Determine”)(“where do I start” vs “where do I stop”) do you tend to favor in your life?

**Look:** *Read the sermon passage. Answer the following textual questions.*

2. How do Proverbs 16:2,5, and 25 show the necessity of partnership with God?
3. Where is the Paradoxical nature of partnership revealed in Proverbs 16?
4. Why is there a cost to this partnership with God according to Proverbs 16:3?
5. How is the face to face reality of partnership with God seen in John 1:1-14?

**Took:** *Applying the message to our lives.*

6. If arrogance of heart is an abomination to God, where is your heart too high?
7. What plan do I need to roll toward God?
8. What cost have I been unwilling to pay in order to plan in partnership with God?
9. What new plans do I need to make face to face with God?
