- · "You are my child."

Messages that God speaks to me, from His Word:

- "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you."
- · "Do not fear."
- · "I am with you ... always."
- · "I will provide all of your needs."
- · "Be still and know that I am God."
- · "My grace is sufficient for you."

 - · "Listening/hears" (3x)
 - · "Called" (11x)
 - · "Samuel" = "God hears" (21x)
