Where Have We Been?

Missions Foundation

- The Chapel has a vibrant history of obedience to Jesus' command to make disciples
- Hired a full-time Missions Pastor (who spent a decade on the field in missions)

The Challenge

- The number of missions is beyond our ability to effectively manage, to maintain the depth of partnership desired, and to communicate missionary updates to the congregation
- Inconsistencies have developed in the processes of selecting &funding our missions

The Charge

- Chapel leadership charged the Missions Leadership Team (MLT) to reduce the number of missionaries to a more manageable level
- Chapel leadership charged the MLT to develop a process/policy to guide us in maintaining healthy & consistent relationships with our partners

The Response

- Conducted 1-2 hour interviews with "Missions Stakeholders" to better understand where the Lord is leading the Chapel's Mission Program
- Began reviewing and restating the Missions Program Vision and Purpose
- Defined criteria of most importance in evaluating a mission partner which was approved by Chapel Leadership
- Developed and sent each supported missionary a form to collect data needed to evaluate
- The Missions Leadership Team (consisting of the Missions Pastor and Missions Deacons) systematically reviewed and apply weighted criteria for each mission partner (hundreds of hours)

Where are we now?

- Recommendations submitted to Staff Leadership Team (Lead Pastor & Team Leaders) for their input
- Presented revised recommendations to the Elder's Ministry Committee
- Ministry Committee has presented to and approved by the Elders
- Initial communication to church body at February 19 Chapel Family Update

Where are we going?

Deeper Relationships

- Invest more deeply in our partners, not only financially, but physically, strategically and spiritually
- Present our missions partners to our congregation through visits and updates
- Present our congregation to our missions' partners by sending teams twice yearly to each long term strategic partner

Strategic Locations

- Be obedient to where the Spirit will lead us in long-term mission strategies
- Special consideration given to areas where we have multiple existing mission partners
- Special attention given to locations of less than 2% reached (these areas less likely to be reached without international missionary support)

• Begin shifting our focus toward church planting locally, nationally and globally
